**FORM** Vial containing 250mg powder for reconstitution.

**INDICATION** 1. Penicillin antibiotic used in the treatment of infection where sensitivities

or guidelines dictate.

2. severe infections including Listerial meningitis, group B streptococcal

infection and enterococcal endocarditis.

#### **DOSE RANGE**

1. Penicillin antibiotic used in the treatment of infection where sensitivities or guidelines dictate.

AGE	DOSE	FREQUENCY	ROUTE
< 7days	50mg/kg per dose	every 12 hours	IV
7days – 6 months	50mg/kg per dose	every 8 hours	IV

## 2. Severe infections including Listerial meningitis, group B streptococcal infection and enterococcal endocarditis

AGE	DOSE	FREQUENCY	ROUTE
< 7days	100mg/kg per dose	every twelve hours	IV
7 – 28 days	100mg/kg per dose	every eight hours	IV
1 – 6 months	50mg/kg per dose	every 4 to 6 hours	IV

**RECONSTITUTION** Add 2.3ml water for injection BP to each 250mg vial and shake gently

until completely dissolved, to produce a 100mg/ml solution.

**DILUTION** No further dilution required.

METHOD OF Injection may be given as a slow iv bolus without further dilution over 3-

ADMINISTRATION 5minutes

Intermittent infusion over 30minutes
