**FORM** Vial containing 50 mg powder for reconstitution

INDICATION Antifungal for the prophylaxis or treatment of severe systemic fungal

infections

#### **DOSE RANGE**

**RECONSTITUTION** Reconstitute each 50mg vial with 12ml of Water for Injection (to give

final concentration of 4mg/ml). Shake vigorously for 30seconds.

#### **DILUTION**

AmBisome 4mg/ml	5ml (Draw up using the 5 micron filter provided)	
Glucose 5%	up to 20ml total	

To give a 1mg/ml solution then give the required volume.

(If a more concentrated solution is required, discuss with pharmacy)

METHOD OF

ADMINISTRATION Infuse slowly over 30 minutes. Flush line before and after infusion with

glucose 5% only
