INDICATION1. First line antibiotic for treatment of early sepsis.Treatment of infections where sensitivities indicate.

RECONSTITUTION Reconstitute a 600mg vial of Benzylpencillin with 5.6ml Water for

Injection to give a 600mg in 6ml solution (Displacement Volume

0.4ml/600mg).

DILUTION NOT REQUIRED

METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION

Slow IV Bolus / infusion over 5-30 minutes.

Dosage guide:

- 600mg in 6ml
- 100mg in 1ml
- 10mg in 0.1ml

NB. Longer administration time is particularly important when using high doses as too rapid administration has been associated with CNS toxicity and convulsions.
