INDICATION Treatment of severe infection or meningitis where sensitivities indicate.

Reconstitute a 500mg vial of Ceftazidime with 4.6ml Water for Injection

to give 500mg in 5ml Solution

500mg in 5ml100mg in 1ml

• 10mg in 0.1ml

(When withdrawing the reconstituted solution ensure the syringe plunger remains fully depressed and the needle remains within the solution and

does not enter the head space).

DILUTION Not required

METHOD OF ADMINISTRATION

By slow IV bolus over 2 - 3 minutes.
