## **Neostigmine**

**FORM** Oral solution – special order manufacturer.

Neostigmine injection 2.5mg/ml (as metilsulfate) - for use as an oral

solution.

**INDICATION** Treatment of Myasthenia Gravis

#### **DOSE RANGE**

AGE	DOSE	FREQUENCY	ROUTE
Neonate	1 to 2 mg	Single initial dose, give 30 minutes before feeds	Oral
Neonate treatment dose	1 to 5 mg	Every 4 hours, give 30 minutes before feeds.	Oral
1 month – 6 months	7.5mg	Initially 7.5 mg, repeated at suitable intervals throughout the day, total daily dose 15 mg to 90 mg.	Oral
> 6 months	See paediatric monographs		

### Additional dosage information:

1mg orally is ~equivalent to 33microgram IV or to 65-100 microgram given by IM or SC injection.,

This gives a 2mg/ml solution for oral use
