RECONSTITUTION Reconstitute each 600mg vial with entire contents of solvent ampoule

provided to give a 60mg/ml solution. MUST be further diluted prior to

use.

DILUTION CENTRAL use

Rifampicin 60mg/ml	1ml
Glucose 5% infusion	Up to 10ml total

This gives a 6mg/ml solution. Use the required volume.

PERIPHERAL use

Rifampicin 60mg/ml	0.5ml
Glucose 5% infusion	Up to 30ml total

This gives a 1mg/ml solution. Use the required volume

METHOD OF

ADMINISTRATION Give by intravenous infusion over 2 hours.

COMPATIBILITY

Solution compatibility	Sodium chloride 0.45% & 0.9%, glucose 5% & 10%.
Solution incompatibility	Most other I.V. fluids.
IV Line compatibility	Vancomycin
IV Line incompatibility	All other drugs.
