	Maximum dose: 5mg OR 1.3mg/kg whichever results in higher dose	Every 4 hours	Oral

NB: Doses > 5mg 4hourly are above BNFc recommendations and must be prescribed on consultant advice only. Caution in long term use.

For conversion from continuous IV infusion to oral 100micrograms/kg/hour IV is equivalent to 800micrograms/kg/dose every 4 hours

Stop IV infusion after SECOND oral dose

FURTHER INFORMATION Reconstitute the contents of the bottle with 90 ml (3 x 30 ml)

of sterile water using the 30ml cup provided and then shake

vigorously for 30 seconds.

Shake the bottle vigorously for a minimum of 10 seconds prior

to withdrawing the required dose.

Avoid abrupt withdrawal of treatment

STORAGE Store powder and reconstituted solution at room temperature.

After reconstitution, the oral suspension is stable for 30 days

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LICENSED STATUS Unlicensed in children under 1 year of age
