# Glucagon

FORM Vial containing 1mg powder for reconstitution and supplied diluent

**INDICATION** Treatment of persistent hypoglycaemia.

a) Hypoglycaemia associated with diabetes

b) Endogenous hyperinsulinism

a) Hypoglycaemia associated with diabetes

	2.5-10micrograms/kg/hour	Continuous infusion	IV Infusion

PRESCRIPTION OF 1.25mg/kg in 50ml infusion fluid

CONTINUOUS INFUSION This gives:-

• 10 microgram/kg/hour at 0.4ml/hour

**RECONSTITUTION** Use diluent provided to give a concentration of 1mg in 1ml.

DILUTION For continuous Infusion

Using 1mg in 1ml injection
