### **FURTHER INFORMATION**

- Paraldehyde can melt plastic. However, if given within 10 minutes of drawing up a plastic syringe can be used for administration
- Avoid contact with plastics and rubber
- Do not use solution if it has a brownish colour or a sharp penetrating odour of acetic acid
- Avoid contact with uncovered skin- if solution touches uncovered skin, wash for at least 10 minutes with cold running water. May cause local irritation around the site of administration'
